#### We asked, You Told Us! Results of SNC's questionnaire on Communication and Transportation are in!

Thanks to all members who took time to answer our questionnaire on Communications and Transportation! We had a very robust response. Of the approximately 110 members we reached out to by email or phone, 34% gave us answers. That's a very good response rate by most measures.

What we learned is that nearly all of you (approximately 90%) use email and prefer that means of communication with Shen Neighbors.

The concept of carpooling is attractive to over 45% of the respondents. That is truly in keeping with our mission of neighbors helping neighbors. We will continue efforts to our out-of-the-house events.

We do appreciate the comments that several people sent. We will take them all to heart.

everything maple.
