
There will be demonstrations and presentations. Get a preview of the Southern Saratoga County YMCA's Active Older Adult programs demonstrated in the studio at the Center.

The group will meet at the second larger parking lot that has a bathroom at the pavilion. It's at the end of the gravel road. We will begin with a BYO lunch followed by a walk at Veteran's Memorial Park. This area of undulating terrain affords hiking across small watercourses, past wetlands and hemlock and pine uplands. It's an ideal habitat for deer, turkey, small mammals, and a variety of birds.
